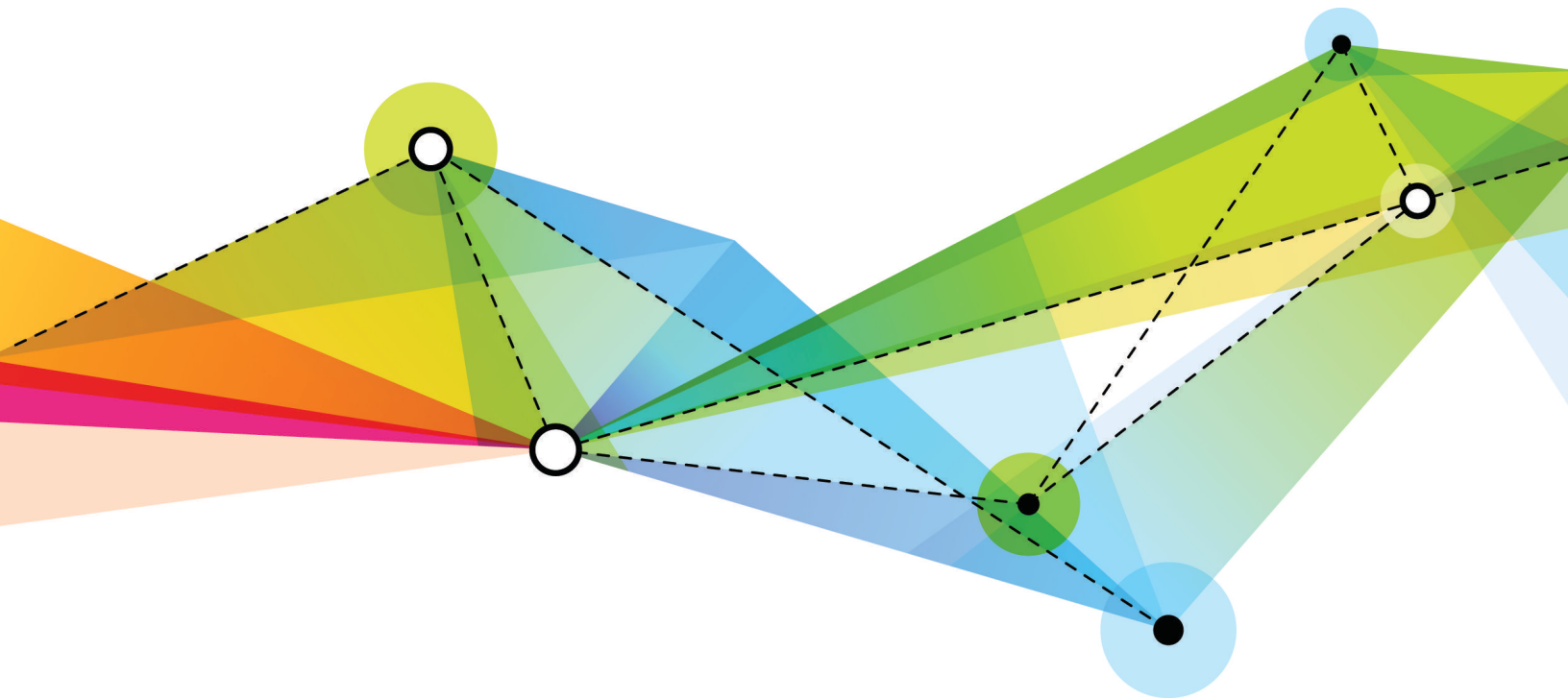

Closed user group importer specification

Smile provides the ability to import a Comma Separated Values (CSV) file to add closed user group members into existing closed user group(s).

File format

A closed user group importer file is a CSV formatted document containing two record types:

- **header**—contains the column names for the entry records
- **entry**— contains the actual import data of interest, one entry for each closed user group member

Commas separating unused columns at the end of a line may not be omitted.

Header

The first line is a single header containing column names for the entries, separated by commas. The importer will display an error if the header line is not included in the CSV.

Entry

An entry contains the actual import data of interest. One entry for each closed user group member.

Table 1: Entry record field definition

Col	Field name	Data type	Description	Required?
0	CUG Name	Text	The existing closed user group name.	Yes
1	Phone Number	Text	The identifier of each member in the group.	Yes
2	Valid From	Timestamp ISO Standard	Date and time that the member is valid from. Formatted YYYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss+Z. For example: 2016-01-01T00:00:00+10:00.	No
3	Valid To	Timestamp ISO Standard	Date and time that the member is valid to. Formatted YYYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss+Z. For example: 2016-01-01T00:00:00+10:00.	No
